

Our Bible Camp Traditions

- 1 In order to provide a healthy environment, bullying and any other harassing behaviors will not be allowed.
- 2 Please respect and do not harm any property, nature or person. Leave all animals alone.
- 3 Help keep camp clean by using properly marked containers for garbage and recyclables.
- 4 Safety is our concern and all waterfront rules must be obeyed. Waterfront activities are done only when the waterfront staff is on duty.
- 5 There is a Low and High ropes challenge course at Ox Lake. These elements require authorized camp staff to be on duty when in use.
- 6 For your safety, always wear shoes/sandals, except on the beach. (WCB requires closed-toe shoes. NO sandals, please).
- 7 Do not sit on porch railings, stairwells, or tables.

- 8 Campers may not enter other cabins or tents.
- 9 A camp staff member must accompany all campers whenever outside of camp property.
- 10 We are God's creation and believe it is important to take care of our bodies. We offer an alcohol free, smoke free and substance abuse free environment.
- 11 Camp is weapon free. Campers must not bring any kind of weapon or explosive device, including firecrackers.
- 12 Camp reserves the right to hold inappropriate personal items of campers. Return of the item will, if appropriate, be made at the end of the camper's stay; parental contact and authorization may be necessary for this return.
- 13 All medications must be turned into the Camp Health Supervisor during registration. Campers should not bring non-prescription medication i.e. aspirin/band-aids, etc. 1st aid staff provides as needed.

- 14 Campers may make a phone call upon approval and accompaniment of counselor.
- 15 Every camper is expected to follow the entire camp schedule, unless excused by the Director, or as stated on Health History. If you are injured or do not feel well, report at once to your counselor.
- 16 Campers may be transported in vehicles designed for passengers only. Only camp vehicles will be used to transport campers, unless designated by the Director.
- 17 Only personnel approved and trained may operate any type of power tool.
- 18 Early release of campers who are minors will be possible by verbal and written permission of the child's custodial parent or guardian. If this is a concern, please contact the camp office.
- 19 Breaking any of these rules gives the Camp Director the right to send the camper(s) home without a refund. ***Signature required on camp registration card.***
