Hybrid trips at Wilderness Canoe Base are wonderful ways to combine a canoe trip with a mission trip. Hybrid trips are very adaptable to the desires of your group. You can choose to have work service as the first or second half of your week. While hybrid groups typically spend the second part of their week on trail, your group can instead decide to spend that time at Base doing fun Island Camp activities - rock climbing, hiking, games, day trips, campfires, berry picking, etc. Either way, this part of your week will be full of new experiences and is guaranteed to be rewarding, exciting, beautiful, enriching, adventurous, and refreshing.

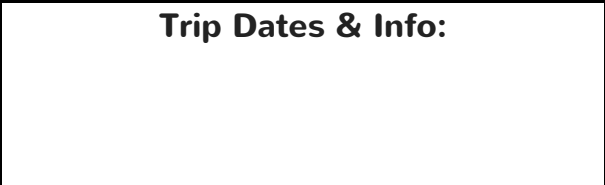
WORK-SERVICE TIME

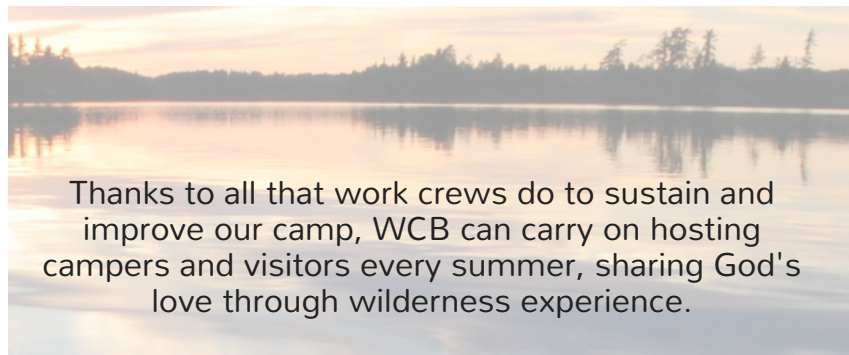


Your group will be assigned a guide for the week who will show you the ways of the wilderness and lead your group in activities including work projects, canoeing, hiking, and Bible study.
