



### **Summer's Almost Here!**

Despite the recent blizzard we endured in April, it's hard to imagine that staff training begins in just a few weeks! We cannot be more excited for all that the Lord has planned for the campers that will arrive in June, the staff that will lead them, and for how God will use Lake Wapogasset Lutheran Bible Camp to glorify the name of Jesus.

We have already seen God's provision in the increase of registrants for our various programs at both Wapo and Ox Lake. At Camp Wapo, our Seeds weekend program, has record registered campers in comparison to past years; our One Day program continues to grow allowing our youngest campers to experience camp for a day in preparation for coming for an overnight stay in the Seeds program; and our Youth program is on its way to reach capacity again this summer.



# New High School Programs

Servant Leadership Program (SLP) is a discipleship program at the Wapo site allowing high school students to explore leadership in the camp setting and step into opportunities with youth campers to give them a taste of counseling. Senior High Camp will be set at Ox Lake and provide a week of fun and faith formation designed for high schoolers. In both programs, campers will experience dynamic growth and incredible community to spur them forward in their walk with Christ.

This spring we are adding electricity out to the 2<sup>nd</sup> site where youth camp happens. We are also redoing the road out to that site for easier access. Ox Lake is also seeing an increase of summer campers! Therefore, another project for the spring will be to construct another new cabin to accommodate this increase in campers. We are thrilled to see the growth of Ox Lake, for it provides a unique and different camp experience to continue encouraging campers in their walk with the Lord!
