Weekend Theme: "Drawn to the Word - Seeing Our Way Through the Bible" - Join Artist and Pastor Paul Oman on this visual journey through the Bible. You will experience the storyline of the Old and New Testaments come to life as Paul draws and paints these encounters before your eyes. You will see and remember the "big picture" of the Bible, and in particular, the larger-than-life place Jesus holds for you. Music and sound effects will be incorporated into this visual process. 50% or more of the teaching time will directly engage Paul's drawing and painting skills, with the remaining time for discussion of theological and cultural insights, and application.

Receiving national & international recognition for his work in watercolor, Paul uses this gift to proclaim the Gospel unique and powerful ways that impact lives and inspire mission.

Paul works in many settings, including congregations, schools, universities, seminaries, camps, prisons, non-profits, and more. The larger-than-life sized murals are painted with acrylics on stretched canvas.
