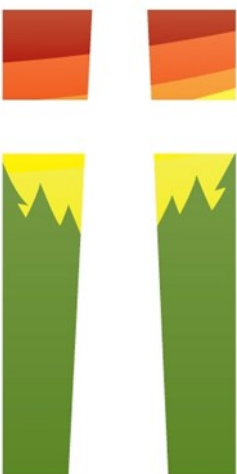
Joshua 1:9
